| 3. Aiden has 4 pairs of trainers in shoeboxes. All four shoeboxes have a total volume of $16\,000\text{cm}^3$. What is the volume of each shoebox? | |
| 4. Sophia's old cupboard measured 1m high, 50cm wide and 50cm deep. Now she has a new cupboard with the same height and depth but which is 0.5m wider. What is the difference in the volumes of the 2 cupboards? | |
| 5. Jacob's birthday cake measures 25cm long, 30cm wide and 10cm deep. How many equal pieces can his mum cut, if each piece has a volume of 375cm^3 ? | |
| 6. Mr Lee's new suitcase is 1m long, 0.75m wide and 30cm deep. The volume is twice as big as the volume of his old suitcase. What was the volume of his old suitcase? | |
