1. Alison is making a cake and needs to measure 100ml of milk. Her jug will only hold 25ml. How many times will she need to fill her jug?	4
2. Maria wants to pour 3 equal cups of juice for her friends. Her jug has 300ml of juice. How much juice will each friend have?	100ml
3. Ali and Fiona are sharing a bottle of water equally. The bottle holds 0.4l of water. How much do they each drink in millilitres?	200ml
4. If Karen drinks 4 full cups of tea each having 250ml, in a day, how much tea does she drink altogether, in litres?	1l
5. Carl's mum asked him to buy 3l of milk. The bottles in the shop each hold 500ml. How many bottles does Carl need to buy?	6
6. Helen is packing 5 lunchboxes, each with 1 carton of apple juice. Each carton holds 50ml. How much juice is there in total, in litres?	0.25l
