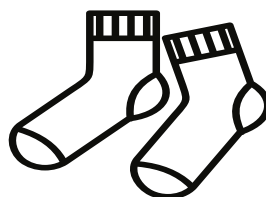

Word problems – multiplication

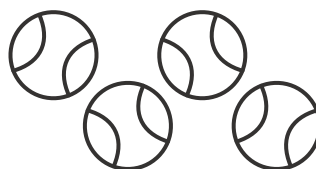
1. Oliver has 8 pairs of socks. How many socks does he have altogether?

3. Leo bought 5 new boxes of tennis balls. Each box has 4 balls. How many balls are there altogether?



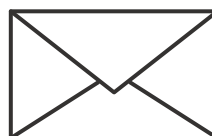
4. A farmer collected 3 baskets of eggs. Each basket had 12 eggs inside. How many eggs did he have altogether?
