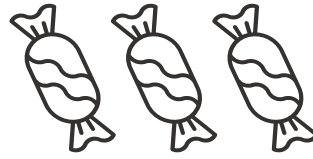

Word problems – division

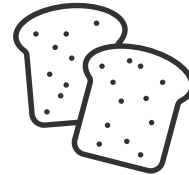
1. A group of friends shared **21** sweets.

How many shelves are there?



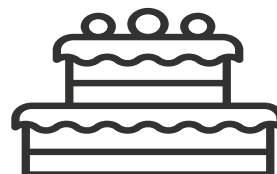
5. My friends and I go on a bike ride.
