## Answer sheet

$$3\frac{1}{4} - 2\frac{1}{5} = 1\frac{5}{20} - \frac{4}{20} =$$

$$1\frac{1}{20}$$

$$1\frac{2}{3} - 1\frac{1}{7} = \frac{14}{21} - \frac{3}{21} =$$

$$\frac{11}{21}$$

$$2\frac{3}{5} - 1\frac{1}{2} = 1\frac{6}{10} - \frac{5}{10} =$$

$$1\frac{1}{10}$$

$$4\frac{5}{6} - 2\frac{1}{4} = 2\frac{10}{12} - \frac{3}{12} =$$

$$2\frac{7}{12}$$

$$5\frac{3}{8} - 2\frac{1}{3} = 3\frac{9}{24} - \frac{8}{24} =$$

$$3\frac{1}{24}$$

$$4\frac{2}{3} - 1\frac{2}{5} = 3\frac{10}{15} - \frac{6}{15} =$$

$$3\frac{4}{15}$$

$$6\frac{4}{7} - 2\frac{1}{2} = 4\frac{8}{14} - \frac{7}{14} =$$

$$4\frac{1}{14}$$

$$5\frac{7}{10} - 3\frac{1}{4} = 2\frac{14}{20} - \frac{5}{20} =$$

$$2\frac{9}{20}$$

$$2\frac{8}{9} - 1\frac{1}{2} = 1\frac{16}{18} - \frac{9}{18} =$$

$$1\frac{7}{18}$$
