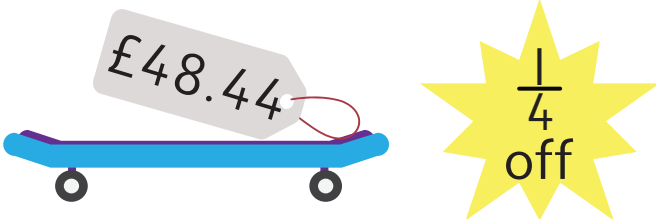


Fractions and decimals

The toy shop has a sale. Fill in this table of prices.

Toy	New price
	$\frac{1}{4}$ of 48.44 = 12.11 $48.44 - 12.11 = \text{£}36.33$
	$\frac{1}{2}$ of 21.00 = 10.50 $21.00 - 10.50 = \text{£}10.50$
	$\frac{2}{3}$ of 18.30 = 12.20 $18.30 - 12.20 = \text{£}6.10$

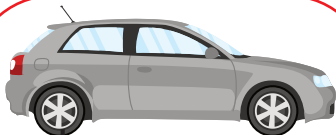
Work out the new prices for each car then circle the cheapest one.



$\frac{1}{3}$ off £9033

$$\frac{1}{3} \text{ of } 9033 = 3011$$

$$9033 - 3011 = \text{£}6022$$



$\frac{1}{6}$ off £4860

$$\frac{1}{6} \text{ of } 4860 = 810$$

$$4860 - 810 = \text{£}4050$$



$\frac{1}{4}$ off £6420

$$\frac{1}{4} \text{ of } 6420 = 1605$$

$$6420 - 1605 = \text{£}4815$$
